Lacey bought her first property at age 19 while still a full-time student.

Now in her early 30's, Lacey has acquired six properties, has a strong balance sheet and earns \$50,000 a year from her investments on top of her professional income – when she chooses to work.

Lacey credits her success to her mother, who taught her how to manage money from an early age.

Aware that schools teach mathematics, science and English, but not how to manage money, and realising that many parents lack the knowledge to teach their children themselves, Lacey founded Money School to close the education gap.

Money School educates parents on money management so they can teach future generations, who are facing increased responsibility to manage their own financial futures in the wake of an ageing population and limited Government assistance.

Lacey's plain English approach to explaining how she built her own portfolio and recounting the lessons she learnt along the way demystifies financial management.
